



Drilling in the Cleary area continues to unlock higher-grade potential to the south. Hole GS2546 **returned 216.4 m at 2.44 g/t Au from 255.1 to 471.5 m (end-of-hole)**

Six well mineralized intervals, including four higher grade intercepts, further strengthening confidence in the continuity of higher-grade mineralization within the current resource area

The deepest higher-grade zone was encountered at the predicted target depth and ended with **11.54 g/t Au over 29.5m**, but was lost before the full extent of the zone could be tested; the hole was originally targeted to 700 m.
